- Clipstone Football Club £1000 grant used for general running costs including grass seed and
- Clipstone Welfare Youth Club £10,000 used towards overheads and consumables to operate the Youth Club for children from Clipstone, Kings Clipstone, Forest Town, Berry Hill and Ollerton.
- Clipstone Detachment, Nottinghamshire Army Cadet Force £1000 used towards minibus roof repairs

The Chairman provided the following summary of what has been keeping Council busy in the 2023/2024 civic year:

- A fire alarm upgrade has been completed and commissioned
- Emergency lighting upgrade has been completed
- Emergency signage has been upgraded
- Replacement fire extinguishers have been installed
- Village hall improvements painting, and larger office space
- Maintaining cemetery many complements received regarding how well kept the cemetery is
- Grass verge cutting
- Replacement and additional dog waste bins (eg Intake woods)
- Provided £14,162 to the local community in grants
- Updating Council policies and procedures
- Updating cemetery documentation onto electronic records
- King Charles III Coronation
 - Decorative signs
 - Flag
 - Post box topper
 - Handprint bunting
 - Commemorative mugs
 - Sponsored the Coronation Big lunch event children's entertainment
- Citizens Advice outreach sessions have commenced use of the service is excellent, with both user and CAB feedback positive
- Tidiness in the village drove a week of action has taken place commencing on Monday 21 August, bringing together staff from Notts County Council / Via, Newark and Sherwood District Council and Clipstone Parish Council
- New festive lighting on Cavendish Estate
