CPC20-137 To receive apologies for absence.

Apologies for absence had been received from Cllrs Crowshaw and Ford for personal reasons and Cllr JC Wigman for work reasons.

CPC20-139 To receive a report from the County and District Councillors.

Cllr Peck reported that the resurfacing of Mansfield Road would be going ahead, but footpaths would not be done. A good smooth surface should be achieved.

CPC20-140 To receive disclosures of pecuniary and non-pecuniary interests pursuant to section 31 Localism Act 2011 from councillors on matters considered at this meeting.

# Cllr Clarey declared an interest in item CPC20-143 as a trustee of CMWCT, the football club and secretary of the allotments association.

CPC20-141 To determine which items on the agenda, if any, require the exclusion of public and press under the Public Bodies (Admissions to Meetings) Act 1960 1 (2) and resolve to exclude public and press for these items.
