Background

Clipstone Parish Council's events budget for 2023/2024 is £2500.

A request has been received from Clipstone Miners Welfare Social Club for a donation towards the Christmas Lights Switch On Event on Saturday 25 November 2023.

Clipstone Miners Welfare propose the following options for donations:

- 3 x characters booked from Little Princess Parties (2 Frozen characters and the grinch) for 1 hour 30 minutes, performing songs for 30 minutes and then walk about for an hour. The cost is £360 plus VAT.
- Fireworks at a cost of £870 for a duration of 8 minutes.

Council expenditure on festive lighting

Councils festive lighting budget for the 2023/2024 year is £8000. This has been exceeded due to purchasing additional lighting columns for the Cavendish Estate.

Summary

The remaining Clipstone Parish Council events budget for 2023/2024 is £508.26.

Despite the loss of Councils General Power Competence following elections in May 2023, it is possible for Council to support external providers events in the village through the Local Government Act 1972, section 144, The power to contribute to encouragement of tourism.

Recommendation

Council should consider if it would like to hold any events itself during the remainder of the current financial year, and if a budget should be allocated.
